**SEVEN STONES (SATOLIYA) SPORTS COMPETITION**  
**FOR 3rd, 5th AND 7th SEMESTER**

**GENERAL RULES:**

- At any point of time, the decision of the Referee will be considered final.
- Any kind of abusive/physical misbehavior of any player will lead to disqualification of the whole team with immediate effect.
- I card is compulsory at the time of participation in any event.
- Players cannot Merge with other classes.
- Sports Wear is mandatory

**Team Formation Rules:**

- A team will comprise 5 on-field players and 2 substitutes (A total of 7 per team).
- There should be players from the same class.
- Girls and Boys will have to form their teams separately.

**Game Rules:**

- Team A - Attacking Team, and Team B - Defending Team.
- Maximum 3 chances of throwing.
- Catching team players can only catch with one hand (girls can use both hands).
- Once, team A destroys the pile of stones, A will try to rearrange the stones within 90 seconds. B will try to stop them from doing so by trying to hit players of team A below their head.
- At a time, only one player of Team A is allowed in the inner circle for the rearrangement of stones, and a maximum of 3 players of Team B are allowed in the square but outside the circle.
- Team B has to out 1 player to gain 2 points before the arrangements of the stones by the opposite team. No Points will be awarded to team B if they out only one player.

- If time runs out without arranging the stone, Team B gets 1 point.
- After the rearrangement of stones, the player of Team A should shout 'SATOLIYA' loud and clear while tracing a circle around the pile; then, it gets 2 points. If a player of Team A shouts 'SATOLIYA' without completing the pile in any way, Team B scores one point.
- After three turns of each team, the team with more cumulative points will be declared the winner.
- In case of a tie, the winner will be decided by a bowl out (The team will be awarded a point if and only if they knock out at least one stone. The point will not be considered if the opponent catches the ball after hitting the stone).
- The whole team is considered out if the opponent catches the ball that hits the stones (at least one stone should fall out), and the catching team gets 1 point.
- No player from the defending team (Team B) can touch or make contact with any of the seven stones. (In case of any discrepancy, the Referee's decision will be final).
- The players from team A are allowed to slide the stones on the ground but must not throw them in the air, although they are allowed to carry the stones with them while running.
- Underarm throwing is not allowed.
- Breaking any of the rules will be counted as a foul.
- Holding the ball for more than 5 seconds is considered a foul.
- The referee's decision will be the final.
